Access


Mersch is located in the *Gutland* region, *Alzette* valley, in the center of Luxembourg, 15km north of the city of Luxembourg.

Mersch is located along national highway A7 connected via Luxembourg city to

- German Bundesautobahn A1 (Trier)
- German Bundesautobahn A8 (Saarbrücken)
- French Autoroute A31
- Belgian Autoroute A4 (E411/E25)


Free parking will be available on the seminar site.



Access by Train


Mersch has a train station located on line 10 Luxembourg-Gouvy. It can be reached within less then 30 minutes from Luxembourg central station.

Luxembourg train station is internationally connected to Brussels, Paris, Strasbourg, Trier.



Access by bus

Mersch also has a bus station with national bus line 290 connecting Mersch station with Luxembourg City Center.

Luxembourg airport, "Findel", has flights coming in from a large number of European cities.

Public transport is generally free of charge in Luxembourg. Only first-class train tickets are to be purchased.

Luxembourg Kyudo Federation will organize a shuttle service between Luxembourg airport, Mersch station and the seminar location. The shuttle bus timetable will be arranged in accordance with the arrival times of the participants and will be announced at a later stage.

Accomodation
